

?? TRAILS COMMITTEE ??

The sno-odders shall form a committee to run the trail business of the club. It shall be a stand-alone committee, which will be started by volunteers who are willing to be responsible for their part of the trail system. A majority vote of the club will be necessary to approve these starting people. This committee will establish its rules and regulations. This committee will run the trail portion of the Sno-odders business.

Some suggestions of rules would be:

1 the committee shall consist of (as many as volunteer) people, and may be added to or subtracted from, at any time by unanimous vote of the committee.

2 The Club president (could/should) be on the committee, but the whole committee shall elect a chairman of the group.

3 The committee will determine who has what portion of trail to maintain.

4 The person who is responsible for a section of trail will be called on to check out a problem (fallen tree, etc.) and determine what needs to be done. If more help is needed he may call as many other helpers as he deems necessary.

5 The committee shall meet at least monthly, Sept. through April. The committee should meet through the summer, so it is established by fall of 2010.

6 Each committee member will recruit people to help them with trail marking as they see necessary.
