26th Annual Women on Snow Weekend January 27-29, 2012 Women on Snow Tour January 30-February 2, 2012

Women on Snow is a snowmobile trail riding event which started in Eagle River in 1986. Women from all over the Midwest enjoy riding the trails in Wisconsin's Northwoods and meeting others who love to snowmobile.

Weekend: Registration and check-in for the WOS weekend begins on Friday morning. The trail rides are led by one of six WOS hostesses and begin mid-afternoon on Friday and end on Sunday around noon. Meal and rest stops are made along the way. When the riding is done for the day, there's more fun in store back at the Eagle River Inn Resort—swim in the pool, relax in the hot tub, or socialize in the lounge. Lodging, meals, gas, entertainment, and fun from Friday supper through Sunday brunch is included in the weekend package for just **\$250 per person**.

Tour: The WOS tour is for women who enjoy longer rides at a faster pace. It is open to those who have ridden with WOS previously, including the 2012 weekend. Our planned ride is to the Upper Peninsula of Michigan. We will depart the Eagle River Inn on Monday morning and will stay overnight at the same resort both Monday and Tuesday, and return back to Eagle River on Wednesday afternoon. Meal and rest stops are made along the way. Riders carry their own provisions on their snowmobile, except for oil and a small bag with medications which can be put in the support vehicle. Included in the tour package is lodging Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday; meals Monday morning through Wednesday lunch; and gas for **\$285 per person**.

Registration: Registration forms are available to download from the WOS website at womenonsnow.org or call Judy at 630-341-5251 or Julie at 715-891-1915. The deadline to register is December 15, 2011. Snowmobilers should be familiar and comply with the Wisconsin snowmobile laws. You must be at least 21 years old to register.
