

## Ordinance 126

### An Ordinance entitled Snowmobiles

#### 30.01 State Statues Adopted

State Statues Chapter 350 is hereby adopted and is fully set forth herein.

#### 30.02 Routes and Trails Designated

A. Except as provided in Sections 350.02 and 350.03 of the Wisconsin Statutes, as adopted herein no person shall operate a snowmobile upon any public right-of-way, in any public yard or on any other public property in the Village except as designated in this section. The following streets are designated snowmobile routes:

B. Operation of snowmobiles is not authorized within public parks and recreational areas unless the Village Board approves.

C. Snowmobile Clubs procure, erect and maintain appropriate snowmobile route trail or limit markers with approval of the Village.

D. Snowmobiles operated on designated snowmobile routes over public highways, shall observe the rules of the road for motor vehicles set forth in Chapter 346 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and which is adopted by reference and made a part of this chapter as if fully set forth in this chapter. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by such laws is required or prohibited by this chapter.

#### 30.03 Additional Regulations

A. Speed. No person shall operate a snowmobile at a speed in excess of ten miles per hour upon any trail or route within the Village.

B. Hours of Operation. No person shall operate a snowmobile within the Village between the hours of 1:00 A.M. to 6:00 A.M. except for one entry to reach a specific destination by the most direct route authorized under this section or one exit to leave the Village, and then only as permitted by the provisions of this section.

C. Operation on Sidewalks Prohibited. No person shall operate a snowmobile on any sidewalk or pedestrian way within the Village.

D. Obedience to Laws. The operator of any snowmobile shall observe all traffic laws of the State of Wisconsin as adopted by the Village and shall operate the same on the right-hand side of the right portion of the traveled streets designated as snowmobile routes under section 30.02(A), and when two (2) or more snowmobiles are operated at the same time, they shall be operated in line one behind the other and not abreast.

E. Liability for Operation of Snowmobiles. By operating a snowmobile upon any streets in the Village as permitted herein, the operator thereof assumes full liability for any damage or injuries caused by such operation and agrees to indemnify and save the Village harmless from any claim for damages by reason of such operation.


F. Unattended Snowmobiles. No person shall leave or allow a snowmobile to remain unattended on any public street or public property while the motor is running or with the starting key in the ignition.

G. Section to be Filed. The Village Clerk shall file a copy of this section upon its enactment and publication with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, Local Police Chief and County Sheriff's Department.

### **30.04 Penalties**

Any person who violates any provision of sections 30.02 and 30.03 shall forfeit not more than \$250.00. The penalties for violating any provision of section 30.01 is set forth in Wisconsin Statutes Section 350.11 as adopted herein.
